At the parliamentary elections of 19 May 1991 he was elected Member of the House of Representatives standing as a DISY (*Dimokratikos Synagermos*) candidate in Limassol and was re-elected at the parliamentary elections of 26 May 1996, 27 May 2001 and 21 May 2006.

He has been parliamentary spokesman of the DISY and chairman of the House Standing Committee on Development Plans and Public Expenditure Control.

He was also one of the three vice-chairmen of the Executive Committee of the Cyprus Branch of the Commonwealth Parliamentary Association.

He is parliamentary spokesman of the party, a member of the Committee of Selection, of the House Standing Committee on Institutions, Merit and the Commissioner for Administration (Ombudsman), of the Ad Hoc House Committee on Rules of Procedure and a full member of the Special House Committee on Declaration and Examination of Financial Interests.
