In January 2005, the Assembly held a debate under urgent procedure and adopted Resolution 1420 (2005) on prospects for peace in the Middle East. 18.03.05 – The Bureau asks the Sub-Committee on Middle East to make proposals on the possible organisation of a tripartite forum under Resolution 1420 (2005). 17 to 22.04.05, the Rapporteur made a visit to Jordan, Palestinian Territories and Israel. On 28.04.05, the Committee heard an oral report by the Rapporteur on his visit, held an exchange of views with representatives of Knesset and the Palestinian Legislatif Council and authorised the Rapporteur to carry out another fact-finding mission in the region after the parliamentary elections of the Palestinian Legislative Council. 31.05.2005 – The Committee held an exchange of views with the participation of representatives of the Knesset and the Palestinian Legislative Council, and adopted a draft Resolution and a draft Recommendation. On 28 April 2004, the Assembly adopted Resolution 1372 on the Persecution of the Press in the Republic of Belarus. On 29.04.2005, the Sub-Committee on Belarus held an exchange of views on the case of Mikhail Marinich as well as the political situation in Belarus with the participation of Pavel Marinich (son of Mikhail Marinich) and the Ambassador Joseph (Switzerland), Chair of the GR-EDS. 31.05.2005 – The Committee heard a statement by the Chair of the Sub-Committee on Belarus on the decision of the Bureau to invite political groups to develop contacts with the respective democratic political parties in Belarus and invite their representatives to Assembly part-sessions.
