At its meeting in Paris on 12.09.06, the Committee debated the title of the report, invited the rapporteur to organise a hearing on the issue, authorised the rapporteur to go on a fact-finding visit to Turkey, and asked the Bureau's authorisation for the rapporteur to go on a fact-finding visit to the Maghreb countries. At its meeting in Paris on 7.09.07, the Committee decided to change the title of the report as follows: "Abduction and illegal confinement of women and girls motivated by practices contrary to human rights". The Committee appointed a new rapporteur at its meeting on 4.10.07. At its meeting in Istanbul on 7.12.07, it considered an outline report in the absence of the rapporteur. It asked the Bureau's authorisation for the rapporteur to go on a fact-finding visit to one Maghreb country (Morocco for example) and agreed to organise an exchange of views on this subject at one of its next meetings. On 21.01.08, the Bureau agreed for the reference to be extended until 27.06.08. The Committee considered an introductory memorandum and held a hearing on this issue at its meeting in Paris on 11.03.08. On 14.04.08, the Committee approved a questionnaire which was sent to the national delegations for reply by 30.05.08. On 29.04.08 in Vienna, the Committee decided to ask the Bureau for an extension of the deadline of this report until 15.12.08 in order to give sufficient time for the rapporteur to organise a fact-finding visit to Morocco (subject to the authorisation of the Bureau) and to analyse the replies to the questionnaire. On 29.05.08, the Bureau authorised the rapporteur to carry out a fact-finding visit to Morocco in the framework of the preparation of her report. On 06.06.08, the Committee decided that the national delegations have the possibility to send back the questionnaire until 30 June 2008.
