Control over the situation with human rights in Belarus, Mr Aleh Hulak, Chairperson of the Belarusian Helsinki Committee and Mr Stanislav Bogdankevich, Honorary Chairperson of the United Civic Party, as well as Mr Gianni Buquicchio, President of the Venice Commission; appointed Mr Andres Herkel (Estonia, EPP/CD) as rapporteur on the situation in Belarus and authorised him to participate in the Troika meeting on Belarus during the OSCE-PA annual session (Belgrade, 7 July 2011); decided to ask the Bureau to authorise the rapporteur to conduct a fact finding visit to Minsk in the forthcoming months, in the framework of the preparation of his report.

On 5 and 21 July, and on 8 August 2011, the Rapporteur issued statements on issues of concern to the situation in Belarus.
