Paragraph 15 of the Resolution stipulates: "In the light of developments since the adoption of its Resolution 1790 (2011) in January 2011, the Assembly can only reaffirm its decision to put on hold its activities involving high-level contacts with the Belarusian authorities and its call to the Bureau of the Assembly not to lift the suspension of the special guest status for the Parliament of Belarus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - until a moratorium on the execution of the death penalty has been decreed by the competent Belarusian authorities; - until there is substantial, tangible and verifiable progress in terms of respect for the democratic values and principles upheld by the Council of Europe."
