## To the members of the Committee on Political Affairs and Democracy

### Synopsis of the meeting held in Strasbourg in a hybrid manner on 21 April 2022

The **Committee on Political Affairs and Democracy**, meeting in Strasbourg in a hybrid manner on 21 April 2022, with Ms María Valentina Martínez Ferro (Spain, EPP/CD), third Vice-Chairperson, in the Chair, as regards:

- **General policy debate on Consequences of the Russian Federation's aggression against Ukraine** (*Rapporteur: Mr Frank Schwabe, Germany, SOC*): heard a statement by the Rapporteur followed by an exchange of views; considered a draft report, agreed to a proposal by the Rapporteur to change the title of the report as follows: *Consequences of the Russian Federation's continued aggression against Ukraine: role and response of the Council of Europe*; unanimously adopted a draft resolution as amended, and adopted a draft recommendation as amended;
- **Appointment of a Rapporteur**: appointed, by acclamation, Mr Bogdan Klich (Poland, EPP/CD) Rapporteur on *Recent challenges to security in Europe: what role for the Council of Europe?*, and heard from him a declaration of absence of conflict of interests;
- **Meeting of the Committee in Chania, Crete (Greece), 16-17 May 2022**: took note of the draft programme of the meeting and the practical information;
