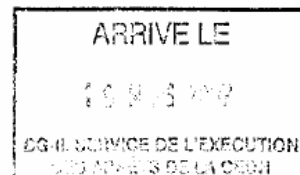
I refer to the letter of 21 December 2006 concerning the procedure for electing a new judge to the European Court of Human Rights in respect of the Republic of Macedonia.
