Letter from the Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe to the President of the Parliamentary Assembly, dated 14 June 2007

Dear President,

Partial renewal of the European Court of Human Rights

Pursuant to decisions adopted yesterday by the Ministers’ Deputies, I have the honour to bring to the attention of the Parliamentary Assembly the lists of candidates submitted by the governments of Albania, Andorra, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Denmark, Georgia, Hungary, Italy, Moldova, Romania, San Marino, Spain, “the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia”, Turkey and Ukraine.

These lists of candidates together with their curricula vitae are presented in English and French in the enclosed documents, it being understood that this communication represents the nomination of candidates by the High Contracting Parties named above in fulfilment of their obligation under Article 22, paragraph 1, of the European Convention on Human Rights.
