Secretariat of the Assembly Synopsis 20 November 2014

The **Standing Committee**, meeting on 18 November 2014 in Brussels, with Ms Anne Brasseur, President of the Assembly, and then with Mr René Rouquet, Vice-President of the Assembly, in the Chair:

- heard a welcome address by Ms Christine Defraigne, Speaker of the Belgian Senate, and held an exchange of views with Mr Didier Reynders, Minister for Foreign and European Affairs of Belgium, Chairperson of the Committee of Ministers;
- ratified the credentials of new members of the Assembly submitted by the delegations of Belgium, France, Romania, Sweden and the United Kingdom;
- approved changes in the composition of Assembly committees;
- took note of the preliminary draft agenda of the first part-session of the Assembly (26-30 January 2015);
- ratified the references proposed by the Bureau which are contained in the Appendix I hereafter;
- took note of the reports of the Ad hoc Committee of the Bureau on the:

"Observation of the early parliamentary elections in Bulgaria (5 October 2014)"; "Observation of the general elections in Bosnia and Herzegovina (12 October 2014)"; "Observation of the early parliamentary elections in Ukraine (26 October 2014)";
