Communication by the Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly at the 1394th meeting of the Ministers' Deputies¹ (3 February 2021)

¹ This document covers past activities of the Assembly since the meeting of the Bureau on 1 February 2021 (by videoconference) and future activities up to the meeting of the Bureau on 18 March 2021.

I. First part-session of 2021 (25 – 28 January 2021)

A. Election of the President of the Assembly

1. At the opening of the part-session, the Assembly re-elected Mr Hendrik Daems (Belgium, ALDE) as its President for the 2021 Ordinary Session.

B. Election of the Vice-Presidents of the Assembly

2. On 25 January 2021, the Assembly elected its Vice-Presidents (Appendix 1).

C. Election of the bureaux of the Committees of the Assembly

3. The Assembly Committees elected their Chairpersons and Vice-Chairpersons (Appendix 2).

D. Election of the Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe

4. On 26 January 2021, the Assembly elected Mr Bjorn Berge as Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe for a five-year term which will start on 1 March 2021

E. Election of the Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly

5. On 26 January 2021, the Assembly elected Ms Despina Chatzivassiliou-Tsovilis as Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly for a five-year term which will start on 1 March 2021.

F. Election of judges to the European Court of Human Rights

6. On 26 January 2021, the Assembly elected Mr Ioannis Ktistakis and Mr Andreas Zünd as judges to the European Court of Human Rights in respect of Greece and Switzerland.

J. Media coverage

The Winter Session of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) generated substantial media coverage, with many wires noting that the plenary took place in the so-called hybrid format. Some 32 journalists were present in Strasbourg though to report on it, and more than 550 articles (provisional figures) appeared in the international press. More than ¾ of them were published in the Russian (175), Ukrainian (98), Greek (55), Armenian (34) and Georgian (25) media.

The focus of the media attention was the debate on the ethical, legal and practical considerations of the COVID 19 vaccines (*CNN, Agence Europe, ANA, ANSA, Agencia Lusa, Corriere del Ticino, Focus Online, Vedomosti, TASS, Ukrinform, Kathimerini, etc.*), as well as the current affairs debate on the arrest and detention of Alexei Navalny in January 2021 and the debate on the challenge of the credentials of the Russian delegation (*DW, AiF, TASS, Rossiyskaya gazeta, Izvestia, VGTRK, News.ru, RIA Novosti*).

The debate on the progress of the Assembly's monitoring procedure (January-December 2020), the Communication by the Secretary General Marija Pejčinović Burić and the election of Despina Chatzivassiliou-Tsovilis as the first-ever female PACE Secretary General were also highlighted in the press.

On social media, the Assembly's posts registered larger impressions and views than the last session a year ago, apparently benefiting from the "hybrid" format. The YouTube Channel in particular - where each sitting is now streamed live and a recording appears rapidly - showed a large jump, to 32,000 impressions, corresponding to nearly 500 hours of "watch time".

Due to the special circumstances, 12 MediaBox interviews were organised remotely mainly with the Assembly members presenting reports before the Assembly.

II. Observation of elections

➤ Georgia: parliamentary elections (31 October 2020)

On 22 January 2021, the Bureau approved the report of the ad hoc committee and took note of the cancellation of the post-electoral mission.

➤ Kyrgyzstan: presidential election (10 January 2021)

On 22 January 2021, the Bureau took note of the cancellation of the observation mission.

➤ Bulgaria: parliamentary elections (4 April 2021)

On 22 January 2021, the Bureau took note of the list of members of the ad hoc committee and appointed Mr Alfred Heer (Switzerland, ALDE) as its Chairperson. On 1 February 2021, the Bureau took note of the final list of members of the ad hoc committee (Appendix 3).

➤ Albania: parliamentary elections (25 April 2021, tbc)

On 22 January 2021, the Bureau, subject to receiving an invitation, decided to observe these elections and to set up an ad hoc committee composed of 20 members (SOC-7 ; EPP/CD-6 ; EC/DA-3 ; ALDE-3 ; UEL-1) as well as the two co-Rapporteurs of the monitoring committee and to conduct a pre-electoral mission. On 1 February 2021, the Bureau took note of the list of members of the ad hoc committee and appointed Mr. Aleksander Pocij (Poland, EPP/CD) as its Chairperson (Appendix 4).

➤ Palestine parliamentary elections (22 May 2021)

On 22 January 2021, the Bureau, subject to receiving an invitation, decided to observe these elections and to set up an ad hoc committee composed of 20 members (SOC-7 ; EPP/CD-6 ; EC/DA-3 ; ALDE-3 ; UEL-1) and to conduct a pre-electoral mission. On 1 February 2021, the Bureau took note of the provisional list of members of the ad hoc committee (Appendix 5).

➤ Schedule of elections for 2021

On 22 January 2021, the Bureau took note of the calendar of elections for 2021.

III. Other decisions taken by the Bureau (22 January and 1 February 2021)

- **Resolution 1376 (2004) relating to Cyprus:** on 22 January, the Bureau took note of the letters from the two Turkish Cypriot political parties informing the President of the Assembly of the names of the "elected representatives of the Turkish Cypriot community" entitled to sit in the Assembly in 2021, namely Mr Armağan Candan and Mr Özdemir Berova, subject to ratification by the Assembly through the Progress report.

- **Standing Committee meeting (videoconference, 19 March 2021):** on 1 February, the Bureau took note of the draft agenda.

- **Second part-session of 2021 (19-22 April):** on 1 February, the Bureau considered the preliminary draft agenda and left the decision on the format of this part-session (physical/hybrid/remote) to its next meeting.

- **Organisation of committee meetings until 30 June 2021:** on 1 February, the Bureau, taking into account the exceptional circumstances created by the Covid-19 pandemic, decided that committee meetings should be held in a hybrid manner (combined remote and in-person participation of members) or by electronic means of remote communication during the period from 1st February to 30 June 2021. In accordance with Rule 48.1, the committee chairperson shall decide on the format which he or she deems most appropriate when convening the meeting, taking into account safety and accessibility conditions.

- **References and transmissions to committees:** on 1 February, the Bureau extended by six months the validity of all current references to committees.
- **Institutional representation of the Parliamentary Assembly in 2021:** on 1 February, the Bureau decided to invite the committees to review their proposals tacking into account gender balance and postponed the approval of the nominations until its next meeting.
- **Václav Havel Human Rights Prize:** on 1 February, the Bureau took note of the press release of the launch of the 2021 edition of the Prize.

IV. Triilogue meeting

The “enlarged” Trialogue (SG, Bureau of the CM and the Presidential Committee of the Assembly) met on Tuesday 26 January 2021.

V. Co-operation with the Venice Commission

- At its meeting on 27 January 2021, the **Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights** decided to ask the Venice Commission for an opinion on the compatibility with international human rights standards of Law no. 7262 on the Prevention of Financing of the Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction recently passed by Turkey’s National Assembly, amending the Law on Associations and Law on Aid Collection in the framework of the preparation of the report on ***Restrictions on NGO activities in Council of Europe member States*** (Rapporteur: Ms Alexandra Louis (France, ALDE)).
