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### **Communication by the Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly at the 1412<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Ministers' Deputies<sup>1</sup> (22 September 2021)**

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<sup>1</sup> This document covers past activities of the Assembly since the meeting of the Bureau on 6 September 2021 (hybrid format) and the future activities up to the meeting of the Bureau on 24 September 2021 (hybrid format).

## **I. Decisions taken by the Bureau on 6 September 2021**

### **A. Fourth part of the 2021 Ordinary Session (27-30 September 2021)**

On 6 September 2021, the Bureau drew up the draft agenda of the fourth part of the 2021 Ordinary Session (Appendix 1) and took note of the different requests to hold debates under urgent procedure, namely on:

- The “Draft Second Additional Protocol to the Convention on Cybercrime on enhanced co-operation and disclosure of electronic evidence”, tabled by the five political groups. The Bureau also decided to recommend to the Assembly to hold this debate and to refer the matter to the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights;
- “The situation in Afghanistan: consequences for Europe and the region”, tabled by the five political groups;
- “Increased migration pressure on the borders of Latvia, Lithuania and Poland with Belarus”, tabled by Mr Arkadiusz Mularczyk and 23 members of the Assembly.

The Bureau also took note of the request to hold a current affairs debate on “The Western Balkans between democratic challenges and European aspirations: what role for the Council of Europe?”, tabled by the five political groups.

On 9 September 2021, a second request to hold a current affairs debate, entitled “Political persecution of indigenous peoples in Crimea by Russia”, was tabled by the Ukrainian delegation to the Assembly.

The Assembly has received the lists of candidates for the post of a judge to the European Court of Human Rights with respect to the Czech Republic, the Republic of Moldova, the Russian Federation and Ukraine. The elections are scheduled on Tuesday, 28 September (and on Wednesday 29 September, if a second round is needed).

#### **➤ *Provisions regarding conditions of access to the Council of Europe and other health and safety measures in place***

As decided by the Bureau, at its meeting of 24 June 2021, the fourth part of the 2021 Ordinary Session will be held in a hybrid format. To date, 178 members (and 51 secretaries of delegation) have registered as physically attending the part-session.

In addition to members of the Assembly, members of observer and partner for democracy delegations, secretariats of delegations (whose names appear on the Assembly list), as well as official VIP delegations, access to the Palais will be authorised for parliamentary assistants (one assistant per parliamentarian) and honorary members of the Assembly. No other accompanying persons will be given access.

The Council of Europe has introduced a Covid pass which is a self-declaration to respect the health rules for access to Council of Europe buildings. Entry into the Council of Europe premises will thus be possible on presentation of this Council of Europe Covid pass, preferably in paper format.

The Council of Europe will set up a testing station for members who need a RT-PCR test for their return.

The sanitary protocol in force at the Council of Europe, including mandatory mask-wearing and respecting the safety distance, continues to apply strictly in all premises. Therefore, for health and physical distancing reasons, access to the Chamber will be restricted to members of the Assembly (full members and substitutes), members of observer and partners for democracy delegations, Permanent Representatives, as well as to members of the Secretariat whose presence is necessary for the smooth running of the debates. Secretaries of delegations and political groups wishing to communicate with members may have access but cannot sit in the Chamber. The public gallery of the Chamber shall remain closed.

Moreover, the possibility for members to organise a side-event or meeting in the Palais de l'Europe remains suspended. No exhibitions, social events, openings, receptions, etc. may be organised in the lobby of the Assembly Chamber.

## B. Observation of elections

**Armenia: early parliamentary elections (20 June 2021):** the Bureau approved the report of the ad hoc committee ([Doc. 15352](#)).

**Republic of Moldova: early parliamentary elections (11 July 2021):** the Bureau approved the report of the ad hoc Committee ([Doc. 15356](#)).

**Bulgaria: early parliamentary elections (11 July 2021):** approved the report of the ad hoc committee ([Doc. 15355](#)).

**Morocco: parliamentary elections (8 September 2021):** the Bureau confirmed its decision taken via written consultation to observe these elections and to set up an ad hoc committee composed of 11 members (SOC-3; EPP/CD-3; EC/DA-2; ALDE-2; UEL-1); confirmed the appointment of Mr Alberto Ribolla (Italy EC/DA) as Chairperson and approved the list of members to observe these elections (Appendix 2).

**Russian Federation: parliamentary elections (17-19 September 2021):** the Bureau considered the assessment of the pre-electoral mission that took place remotely on 2-3 September 2021, and decided, in accordance with Assembly rules, to hold a second in situ meeting of the ad hoc committee in the format of an Election Assessment Mission, composed of one member from each political group, as follows: Mr Pierre-Alain Fridez (Switzerland, SOC) as its Chairperson; Mr Joseph O'Reilly (Ireland, EPP/CD); Mr Alberto Ribolla (Italy, EC/DA); Mr Jacques Maire (France, ALDE); Mr George Katrougalos (Greece, UEL). The Election Assessment Mission took place on 17-20 September 2021. The statement of the Election Assessment Mission was published on the [website](#). The Ad Hoc Committee will prepare a Memorandum on the findings and conclusions of the Election Assessment Mission, to be submitted to the Bureau of the Assembly, provisionally on 25 November 2021.

**Bulgaria: presidential election (November 2021 - tbc):** subject to receiving an invitation, the Bureau decided to observe this election and to set up an ad hoc committee composed of 20 members (SOC-7 ; EPP/CD-6 ; EC/DA-3 ; ALDE-3 ; UEL-1) as well as the two co-rapporteurs of the monitoring committee; decided to maintain, to the extent possible, the same list of members and Chairperson of the ad hoc committee (Mr Alfred Heer, Switzerland, ALDE), as for previous observations of elections in Bulgaria in 2021.

**Schedule of elections:** the Bureau took note of the updated schedule of the elections.

## C. Other decisions taken by the Bureau

**References and transmissions to committees:** the Bureau approved the references and transmissions as set out in Appendix 3, subject to ratification by the Assembly.

**2021 Václav Havel Human Rights Prize:** the Bureau paid tribute to Ms Marie-Louise Bemelmans-Videc, member of the Selection Panel of the Prize and former member of the Parliamentary Assembly, who passed away on the eve of the meeting of the Selection Panel and took note of the shortlist made by the Selection Panel at its meeting in Prague on 30-31 August 2021, consisting of (in alphabetical order):

- Maria Kalesnikava (Belarus)
- Reporters Sans Frontières
- For security reasons, the identity of the third candidate will be revealed at a later stage.

The award ceremony of the 2021 Václav Havel Human Rights Prize will be held on Monday 27 September at 12h30.

### **VI. Cooperation with the Venice Commission**

➤ The President of the Parliamentary Assembly requested an opinion on constitutional reform in Belarus and its compliance with Council of Europe standards.

➤ A representative of the Venice Commission gave legal advice to the Election Observation Mission to the Kingdom of Morocco from 6 to 9 September 2021.

➤ A representative of the Venice Commission gave legal advice to the Election Assessment Mission concerning the Parliamentary Elections in the Russian Federation, which took place in Moscow from 16 to 20 September 2021.

➤ In the framework of the preparation of a report on *Combating rising hate against LGBTI people in Europe* (Rapporteur: Mr Fourat Ben Chikha, Belgium, SOC), the Committee on Equality and Non-Discrimination, at its meeting of 15 September 2021, decided to request the opinion of the Venice Commission on amendments to the Hungarian legislation adopted on 15 June 2021.
