**Synopsis No 2005/53**

2 May 2005

**The Bureau of the Assembly**, meeting on Friday 29 April 2005 in Strasbourg with Mr René van der Linden, President of the Assembly, in the Chair, as regards:

- *2<sup>nd</sup> Part of the 2005 Ordinary Session (Strasbourg, 25-29 April 2005)*:
  - i. Current affairs debate on “the European Constitutional Treaty”: invited the Political Affairs Committee to consider a possible follow-up;
  - ii. Follow-up to be given to the texts adopted:
    - a. Resolution 1433 (2005) on “Lawfulness of detentions by the United States in Guantanamo Bay”: took note that the President will raise this matter during his visit to Washington in September 2005;
    - b. Resolution 1436 (2005) on “Iran’s nuclear programme: need for international response”: asked the Political Affairs Committee to discuss the follow-up to be given to paragraph 12 of this Resolution calling for the promotion of democratic values, full respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms and an open society in Iran through parliamentary dialogue;
  - iii. Third Summit (Warsaw, 16-17 May 2005): agreed that the Assembly will be represented by the Presidential Committee, the rapporteur of the Political Affairs Committee on the Third Summit, and, if included in the national delegation to the Summit, by the rapporteur of the Committee on Economic Affairs and Development for the Assembly’s opinions on the Council of Europe and Parliamentary Assembly’s budgets for 2006;
- *Standing Committee (Lisbon, 6 June 2005)*: approved the draft agenda and took note of the draft programme;
- *3<sup>rd</sup> Part of the 2005 Ordinary Session (Strasbourg, 20-24 June 2005)*: adopted the draft agenda and drew up the draft order of business;
- *Parliamentary elections in Bulgaria (25 June 2005)*: decided to set up an ad hoc committee of five members (one from each political group) to observe these elections;

- *Parliamentary elections in Albania (June-July 2005)*: decided to increase the number of members of the ad hoc committee to observe these elections to 40 (SOC: 14; EPP/DC: 13; LDR: 6; EDG: 5; UEL: 2);
- *Relations with Belarus*: took note of the memorandum on “strengthening democratic forces in Belarus” prepared by the Sub-Committee on Belarus (of the Political Affairs Committee) and agreed to invite the political groups of the Assembly to develop contacts with the respective democratic political parties in Belarus and to invite representatives of these parties to the Assembly part-sessions;
- *Immunities of Assembly members*:
  - i. took note that the Committee on Rules of Procedure and Immunities had decided to close the procedure concerning Mr Iannuzzi’s request for the defence of his immunity as a member of the Assembly;
  - ii. asked the Committee on Rules of Procedure and Immunities to prepare a report on the interpretation of Article 15 of the General Agreement on privileges and immunities of the Council of Europe;
- *European Committee for the Prevention of Torture and Inhuman and Degrading Treatment or Punishment (CPT)*: drew up the lists of the candidates for the CPT in the following order:

  - ii. did not authorise the Political Affairs Committee to meet in Baku (Azerbaijan) on 3-4 July 2005;
- *Opinion of the Venice Commission on the constitutional situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina and the powers of the High Representative:* took note of this opinion and referred it to the Monitoring Committee for consideration;
- *Exhibitions in the Assembly lobby during part-sessions:* approved the draft decision contained in the memorandum on this matter;
- *Official reports of Assembly debates:* postponed the consideration of this matter to one of its next meetings;
- *Stepping up internal security in the Palais de l'Europe by extending the access control system:* took note of the proposals contained in the memorandum on this matter;
- *International Parliamentary Conference on Pan-European Cooperation dedicated to the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the victory of the anti-Hitler coalition in World War II (15 April 2005, St. Petersburg):* took note of the Final Declaration adopted at this conference;

- *Composition of the Ad Hoc Committee on the implementation of paragraph 5 of Resolution 1416 (2004) on the conflict over the Nagorno-Karabakh region dealt with by the OSCE Minsk Conference*: took note that the UEL group appointed Mr Doros Christodoulides (Cyprus) for the vacant seat;
- *Appointment of a rapporteur for the progress report of the Bureau of the Assembly and of the Standing Committee (29 April - 20 June 2005)*: appointed Mr Glesener (Luxembourg, EPP/CD) as rapporteur;
- *Institutional representation of the Parliamentary Assembly in the European Commission against Racism and Intolerance (ECRI)*: appointed Mr Zingeris (Lithuania, EDG) to represent the Assembly in the European Commission against Racism and Intolerance (ECRI);
- *First Session of the Euro-Mediterranean Parliamentary Assembly (Cairo, 12-15 March 2005)*: took note of the information document by Mr Azzolini on his participation in this meeting and referred it to the Political Affairs Committee for consideration;
- *Inaugural mass of His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI*: heard an oral report of Mr Azzolini on his participation in this inaugural mass and agreed to invite His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI as well as His All Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew to address the Assembly;
- *Date and place of the next meetings*: decided to hold the following meetings:

  - . Strasbourg, Monday 20 June 2005 at 8.30,
  - . Strasbourg, Friday 24 June 2005 at 8.30 am
