Synopsis of the meeting held in Sofia on 26 November 2015

The Bureau of the Assembly, meeting on Thursday 26 November 2015 in Sofia, with Ms Anne Brasseur, President of the Assembly, in the Chair, as regards:

- Meeting of the Standing Committee (Sofia, 27 November 2015):
- i. Requests for a current affairs debate (under Rule 53 of the Rules of Procedure): decided to propose to the Standing Committee to hold a debate on "Combating international terrorism while protecting Council of Europe standards and values" and designated Mr Tiny Kox (Netherlands, UEL) as first speaker;
- ii. Draft agenda: considered and took note of the draft agenda;
- iii. Draft declaration submitted by the Bulgarian delegation: considered and took note of the draft declaration:
- First part-session of 2016 (Strasbourg, 25-29 January): updated the preliminary draft agenda;
- Election observation :
- i. Kyrgyzstan: parliamentary elections (4 October 2015): approved the report of the ad hoc committee;
- ii. Belarus: presidential election (11 October 2015): approved the report of the ad hoc committee;
- iii. *Ukraine: local elections (25 October 2015)*: took note of the press release of the international election observation mission;
- iv. Azerbaijan: parliamentary elections (1 November 2015): approved the report of the ad hoc committee;
- v. Turkey: early parliamentary elections (1 November 2015): approved the report of the ad hoc committee;
- vi. Armenia: referendum on constitutional reforms (6 December 2015): decided to observe this referendum; constituted an ad hoc committee consisting of one member per political group and the corapporteur of the Monitoring Committee on Armenia; appointed Mr Andreas Gross (Switzerland, SOC) as its Chairperson, and approved the composition of the ad hoc committee (Appendix 1);
- **References and transmissions to committees**: considered and approved the references as presented in the Appendix 2, subject to ratification by the Standing Committee;
- Issues raised by the committees:
- Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development: authorised Ms Gabriela Pecková (Czech Republic, EPP/CD) to participate in the International Summit on Human Gene Editing, to be held on 1-3 December 2015 in Washington (USA);

- Other business:

- i. Voting for elections during the fourth part-session of 2015: took note of the letters by Ms Aleksandra Djurović, Chairperson of the delegation of Serbia as well as of the memorandum on "Voting for elections during Assembly's 2015 autumn part-session" prepared by the Secretariat; decided to ask the Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs to consider the rules applicable to election procedures in the plenary Assembly, and to disclose to the Chairperson of the delegation of Serbia a copy of the original lists of members who voted in the elections for the Secretary General of the Parliamentary Assembly and for a judge to the European Court of Human Rights held on 29 September 2015;
- ii. Situation in the Republic of Moldova: authorised the Chairperson of the Monitoring Committee to carry out a fact-finding visit to Chisinau in December 2015 in order to look into the conditions of pre-trial detention of Mr Vladimir Filat, former Prime Minister of the Republic of Moldova, and Mr Grigore Petrenko, former member of the Assembly;
- Resolution 1376 (2004) relating to Cyprus: took note that Mr Özdemir Berova would replace
 Mr Tahsin Ertuğruoğlu as "elected representative of the Turkish Cypriot community" entitled to sit in
 the Assembly;
- Composition of the Monitoring Committee and the Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs:
- i. *Monitoring Committee*: on the basis of proposals made respectively by the European Conservatives Group and the Socialist Group, nominated Mr Ian Liddell-Grainger (United Kingdom, EC), Mr Nigel Evans (United Kingdom, EC) and Ms Manana Kobakhidze (Georgia, SOC), replacing Mr Tedo Japaridze, subject to ratification by the Standing Committee;
- ii. Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs: on the basis of proposals by the European Conservatives Group, nominated Sir Roger Gale (United Kingdom) replacing Mr James Clappison and Mr Ian Liddell-Grainger (United Kingdom) replacing Baroness Judith Wilcox (United Kingdom), subject to ratification by the Standing Committee;
- Institutional representation of the Parliamentary Assembly in 2015: approved the appointment of Mr Sergiy Vlasenko (Ukraine, EPP/CD) as representative at the Group of States against Corruption (GRECO);
- **Meetings elsewhere than Strasbourg and Paris**: authorised the Sub-Committee on the Europe Prize (of the Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development) to meet in Vara (Sweden) on 29-30 November 2015;
