Synopsis of the meeting held by videoconference on 18 March 2021

The Bureau of the Assembly, meeting on Thursday 18 March 2021 by videoconference, with Mr Rik Daems, President of the Parliamentary Assembly, in the Chair, as regards:

- **Communications:**

- i. took note of the communication by the President of the Assembly and of his intention to seize the Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs following an exchange of views about a letter sent to him by Mr Liddell-Grainger;
- ii. took note of the communication by the Secretary General and the Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe;

- **Standing Committee meeting (videoconference, 19 March 2021):**

- i. *Requests for current affairs debates:* took note of the requests tabled by the five political groups to hold current affairs debates on
 - “*Democracies facing Covid-19: the way forward*”, decided to recommend to the Standing Committee to hold this debate and appointed Mr Ian Liddell-Grainger (UK, EC/DA) as the first speaker of this debate;
 - “*Recent developments in Turkey concerning parliamentary democracy*”, decided to recommend to the Standing Committee to hold this debate and appointed Mr Frank Schwabe (Germany, SOC) as the first speaker of this debate;
- ii. *Draft agenda:* took note of the revised draft agenda;

- **Second part-session of 2021 (Strasbourg, 19-22 April):** decided to hold this part-session in a hybrid format and drew up the draft agenda;

- **References and transmissions to committees:** approved the references and transmissions as set out in Appendix 1, subject to ratification by the Standing Committee, and – considering the exceptional circumstances created by the pandemic of Covid-19 and in line with its prior decision to extend the validity of all current references to committees by one year in total - decided to extend the terms of office of the rapporteurs of the Monitoring Committee by one year, including those which may have expired since 30 April 2020 in case there has been no replacement;

- **Election observation:**
 - i. *Bulgaria: parliamentary elections (4 April 2021)*: approved the final list of members of the ad hoc committee to observe these elections (Appendix 2) and took note of the statement by the pre-electoral mission;
 - ii. *Albania: parliamentary elections (25 April 2021)*: approved the final list of members of the ad hoc committee to observe these elections (Appendix 3);
 - iii. *Palestine: parliamentary elections (22 May 2021)*: approved the updated list of members of the ad hoc committee to observe these elections and appointed Mr Claude Kern (France, ALDE) as its Chairperson (Appendix 4);
- **Václav Havel Human Rights Prize**: took note of the memorandum prepared by the Secretary General of the Assembly and re-appointed as members of the Selection Panel Ms Marie-Louise Bemelmans-Videc, for a third term of two years starting from 1 June 2021, as well as Ms Anne Brasseur and Mr Nils Muižnieks, for a second term of two years starting from 1 June 2021;
- **Institutional representation of the Parliamentary Assembly in 2021**: considered the nominations as set up in Appendix 5 and decided to approve them, with the exception of the proposals stemming from the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, which will reconsider them at its 22 March meeting;
- **Participation of members in Parliamentary Assembly plenary sessions and committee meetings**: took note of the information memorandum on the participation of members in Parliamentary Assembly plenary sessions and committee meetings in 2020 in accordance with Resolution 1583 (2007) and decided to publish the statistics relating to the participation of national delegations on the Assembly's website;
- **Issues raised by committees:**

Committee on Political Affairs and Democracy: authorised Mr Kimmo Kiljunen (Finland, SOC) to carry out a fact-finding visit to Belarus, by the end of 2021, in the framework of the preparation of his report on *Call for an inclusive national political process in Belarus*;
- **Composition of the Monitoring Committee:**
 - on the basis of a proposal by the EC/DA group, appointed Mr Bob De Brabandere and Mr Asim Mollazada as members;
 - on the basis of a proposal by the SOC group, appointed Ms Edite Estrela and Mr Gerardo Giovagnoli as members;
 - on the basis of a proposal by the group EPP/CD, appointed Mr Evripidis Stylianidis and Mrs Laima Liucija Andrikiėnė as members;
- **Composition of the Committee on the election of judges to the European Court of Human Rights**: on the basis of a proposal by the EPP/CD group, appointed Mr Aleksander Pocij as member;
- **Other business**: decided to confer the title of Honorary Secretary General of the Assembly to Mr Wojciech Sawicki, former Secretary General of the Assembly, with effect from the date that he ceased to be Secretary General of the Assembly;
