Synopsis

of the meeting held in a hybrid manner (in Paris + Kudo) on 16-17 September 2021

The Committee on the Election of Judges to the European Court of Human Rights, meeting in a hybrid manner from Paris on 16-17 September 2021, with Mr Titus Corlăţean (Romania, SOC), 2nd Vice-Chairperson, in the Chair, as regards:

- **Consideration of lists of candidates for posts of judge in the European Court of Human Rights:**
 - Ukraine: held interviews with the candidates in respect of Ukraine and adopted its recommendation for the attention of the Assembly;
 - Czech Republic: held interviews with the candidates in respect of the Czech Republic and adopted its recommendation for the attention of the Assembly;
 - Russian Federation: held interviews with the candidates in respect of the Russian Federation and adopted its recommendation for the attention of the Assembly;
 - Republic of Moldova: held interviews with the candidates in respect of the Republic of Moldova and adopted its recommendation for the attention of the Assembly.
- **Other business:**
 - Noted that a meeting between the Committee and the Advisory Panel would be organised in due course.
- **Next meetings:** took note of the forthcoming meeting of the Committee as follows:
 - Paris, 13-14 January 2022 (Council of Europe Office) (to be confirmed).
