Committee on Culture, Science and Education

The **Sub-Committee on the Media** meeting in Strasbourg on 26 June 2003 with Mr Jařab in the chair:

- held an exchange of views on future activities and priorities of the General Rapporteur on the Media (Mr. Mooney; Ireland, LDR);
- was informed on Council of Europe activities in the media field by Mr Poirel, Head of the Media Division in the Directorate General II Human Rights and Mr. Drzemczewski, Head of the Monitoring Department in the Directorate of Strategic Planning and repeated its call for greater transparency;
- discussed its work programme;
- decided to meet in Bucharest on 19-20 September to participate in the IPI Conference on Public Service Broadcasting, subject to the agreement of the Bureau and, failing this, appointed the Chairman and Mrs Domingues to represent it, subject of the availability of funds.

The **Sub-Committee on Youth and Sport** meeting subsequently with its Vice-Chairperson, Mrs Agudo, in the chair:

- held an exchange of views with Mr Martins, Director of Youth and Sport on the main activities of his Directorate;
- took note of a memorandum by Mr Banks on his activity as rapporteur on the situation of gays and lesbians in sport and decided to consider whether to hold a hearing on the basis of a draft report by the rapporteur;
- reviewed its work programme and considered different proposals to be studied;
- decided to hold its next meeting in Strasbourg in principle on Wednesday 1 October 2003.
