28 APRIL 2004

The **Committee on Culture, Science and Education** meeting in Strasbourg on 27 April 2004 with Baroness Hooper in the Chair:

- approved an opinion on the *persecution of the press in Belarus* (Rapporteur: Mrs. Muttonen, Austria, SOC) and adopted amendments to the draft resolution and to the draft recommendation presented by the Political Affairs Committee;
- designated Mr. O'Hara (United Kingdom, SOC) Rapporteur for an Opinion on *the situation in Kosovo*, approved an opinion and adopted amendments to the draft resolution and to the draft recommendation presented by the Political Affairs Committee;
- held an exchange of views on *education for Europe* (Rapporteur: Mr. Prisacaru, Romania, SOC) with the participation of Mr. Birzea, consultant expert, and agreed to adopt the report on Friday 30 April;
- appointed Mr. Reimann (Switzerland, LDR) rapporteur on *questionable investment from Eastern and Central Europe in high level football in Western Europe* (Doc. 10077);
- confirmed Mr. Korobeynikov (Russia, SOC) and Lord Russell-Johnston (United Kingdom, LDR) as rapporteurs on *European education and harmonious development of students* (Doc. 10055) and on *the cultural situation of the Kurds* (Doc. 10089) respectively;
- decided to continue its meeting on Friday 30 April at 8.30 a.m.
