The **Committee on Culture, Science and Education** meeting in Strasbourg on 11 May 2005 with Mr Legendre and Mr Jařab alternating in the chair:

- approved a report and unanimously adopted a draft recommendation on *media and terrorism* (Rapporteur: Mr Jařab, Czech Republic, LDR) and took note that the debate was foreseen for the June part-session of the Assembly;

- held an extended exchange of views with Mr Figel', Commissioner for education, training, culture and multilingualism in the European Commission;

- held an exchange of views with a delegation of the Committee on Culture and Education of the European Parliament, led by its Chairman, Mr Sifunakis;

- discussed its relations with the European Union and in particular with the European Parliament;

- held an exchange of views on *education and balanced development in schools* (Rapporteur: Mr Korobeynikov, Russia, SOC) with the participation of Mrs Rasmussen, Technical Adviser, Promotion of Young People's Health, World Health Organisation; Mr Bazarniy, Director of the Centre for Health Care and Education, Moscow Administration, and Mrs Ólafsdóttir, Head of the Department of School and out-of-school education (DG IV), and asked the rapporteur to revise his draft report in the light of the discussion;

- heard reports by:

- Mrs Brasseur on the ministerial seminar on teaching remembrance through the cultural heritage (Cracov, 4-6 May);
- Mr O'Hara on the European Museum of the Year Award ceremony (Brussels, 7 May);

- decided to request a prolongation of 7 months of the deadline to adopt the report on *university autonomy* (Rapporteur: Mr Jařab, Czech Republic, LDR) as the Prague colloquy had to be postponed until 30 March -1 April 2006 further to the decision by the Bureau not to authorise a meeting there on 2 September 2005;

- added Mr Glăvan (in place of Mr Ionescu) in the Sub-Committee on the Cultural Heritage; Mr Miutescu in the Sub-Committee on Science and Ethics; Mrs. Cazacu (in place of Mr Ionescu), and Mr Miutescu in the Sub-committee on the Media ; Mrs Cazacu and Mr Glăvan in the Sub-Committee on Youth and Sport;
