Synopsis

of the meetings held in Strasbourg on 14 September 2007

The **Committee on Culture, Science and Education** meeting in Strasbourg on 14 September with Mr Legendre in the chair:

- approved a report and adopted unanimously a draft resolution on the dangers of creationism in education (rapporteur: Mrs Brasseur, Luxembourg, ALDE) and took note that the Assembly debate was scheduled for Thursday, 4 October;
- accepted, on the request of the Polish delegation, to postpone its meeting in Poland (Toruń and Bydgoszcz) until a new delegation was appointed and to group its colloquies on European literature in Paris on 11 December 2007;
- heard a report by Mr O'Hara (UK, SOC) on the collapse of his study visit on cultural heritage in the South Caucasus and regretted the lack of consensus and political will for the visit to have taken place;
- welcomed an invitation by the Italian delegation to attend a conference on the role of education and media in the intercultural dialogue (Rome, 14 November 2007);
- appointed the following rapporteurs:
 - Baroness Hooper on the protection of old and traditional crafts (Doc. 11268);
 - Mr Kozma on the promotion of Internet and online media services appropriate for minors (Doc. 11254);
- expressed its support for a report on cultural education as proposed by Mrs Muttonen and others (Doc. 11327 rev);
- decided to hold its next meeting during the October Assembly part-session in Strasbourg (1-5 October 2007)

The **Sub-Committee on Youth and Sport** meeting in Strasbourg on 14 September 2007 with Mr Schneider in the chair:

- held a hearing on the future of the European sport model (Rapporteur: Mr Arnaut, Portugal, EPP/CD) with the participation of representatives of the IOC, European and international sports federations, associations and unions;
- decided to hold its next meeting during the October Assembly part-session in Strasbourg (1-5 October 2007)
