## Synopsis

of the meeting held in Warsaw from 2-3 September 2008

The Committee on Culture, Science and Education meeting in Warsaw on 2-3 September 2008 with Mrs Brasseur in the chair:

- paid a solemn tribute to its long-standing member and former chairman Lord Russell-Johnston;
- heard an introductory address by Mr Boronisław Komorowski, Marshall of the Sejm;

- held an extended exchange of views with Chairs, Vice-Chairs and members of the Committees on Education, Media, Youth, Culture, Science and Sport of the Polish Sejm and Senate;

- approved a report and adopted unanimously a draft resolution and a draft recommendation on **refreshing the youth agenda of the Council of Europe** (Rapporteur: Mr Schneider, France, EPP);

- was informed on the preparation of the events on the occasion of the **re-opening of the European Youth Centre** in Strasbourg on 30 September and 1 October 2008;

- took note of the programme for the **Conference of Ministers responsible for Youth**, Kyiv, 10-11 October 2008 and decided to hold a meeting of the Sub Committee on Youth and Sport on 9 October;

- took note of the motion for a recommendation on **the "Mosquito" youth dispersal device** and decided to ask the Assembly Bureau for a reference for report;

- approved its contribution to the debate on the **activities of the OECD** (Rapporteur: Mr Daems, Belgium, ALDE);

- held an exchange of views on **history teaching in areas of recent conflict** (Rapporteur: Miss Keaveney, Ireland, ALDE) and decided in principle to adopt the report in December with a view to an Assembly debate in January 2009;

- heard a report on **cultural heritage** in Austria (Bergisel Panorama), Azerbaijan (medieval cemetery in Nakhichevan) and in Cyprus from the General Rapporteur, Mr O'Hara (United Kingdom, SOC);

O'Hara, Tekelioglu, Daems, Miss Keaveney and Mr Freire Antunes to its ad hoc sub-committee and appointed Mme Melo (Portugal, SOC) General Rapporteur for the Conference;

- was informed by Mr McIntosh (United Kingdom, SOC) of the **press release on the death of the opposition Ingush journalist, Magomed Yevloyev**, which he intended to issue in his capacity as Standing Rapporteur on threats to the lives and freedom of expression of journalists;

- was informed by Mr. O'Hara on the **Session of the European Youth Parliament** held in Liverpool on 18-27 July 2008;

- prepared the **meeting of a delegation** (consisting of Mrs Brasseur, Miss Keaveney and Mr McIntosh) with the **European Parliament Committee on Culture and Education** (Brussels, 9 September 2008);

- decided to appoint its rapporteurs on strengthening measures to protect and revive highly endangered languages and on Islam, Islamism and Islamophobia in Europe on the basis of short written presentations from candidates;

- **designated** representatives to forthcoming meetings;

- decided to hold its **next meeting** in Strasbourg during the next part session of the Parliamentary Assembly (29 September-3 October 2008).
