## To the Members of the Committee on Culture, Science and Education

### Synopsis

of the meeting held in Paris (Council of Europe Office) on 10 March 2010

The **Committee on Culture, Science and Education**, in the presence of Mr Mateo Sorinas, Secretary General of the Assembly, with Mr McIntosh in the chair,

*as regards:*

**Prohibiting the marketing and use of the “mosquito” youth dispersal device** (*Rapporteur: Mr Wach, Poland, EPP/CD*): considered a draft report, adopted a draft recommendation and expressed the wish that the report be submitted to a plenary part-session of the Assembly because of its importance for youth policy;

**Rethinking creative rights in the internet age** (*Rapporteur: Mr Arnaut, Portugal, EPP/CD*): took position on the amendments tabled to the draft recommendation and thanked Mrs Marland-Militello for presenting the report on behalf of Mr Arnaut at the Standing Committee in Paris on 12 March 2010;

**Education against violence at school** (*Rapporteur: Mr Flego, Croatia, SOC*): considered an outline report and held an exchange of views with:

- Mr Dan Olweus, Professor of Psychology, University of Bergen, Norway,
- Mr Hugues Feltesse, Chief Executive, Office of the French Ombudsperson for Children, Paris,
- Mr George Fotinos, Member, French Committee for UNICEF, Paris;

**Council of Europe museum prize** (*Rapporteur: Mr O'Hara, United Kingdom, SOC*):

- took note of a memorandum prepared by its Chairman,
- asked its Sub-Committee on the Cultural Heritage to review the current Museum Prize scheme and submit to the Committee proposals on requirements for partner institutions as well as on strategies for increased visibility of the Prize,
- asked its Chairman to contact the EMF and the EMA and ask them whether they would be ready to reconsider working together in the implementation of the Museum Prize scheme in co-operation with the Committee, and
- decided that there would not be a call for candidates to the Museum Prize in 2010 and, therefore, no award ceremony in 2011;
