### Synopsis of the meeting held in Paris on 18 and 19 December 2012

The Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media, meeting in the French Senate and the Council of Europe Office in Paris on 18-19 December with **Mr Gvozden Srećko Flego** (Croatia, SOC) in the chair,

- on Tuesday 18 December from 9am to 12 noon, as regards:
  - **Tribute to Mr Lluís Maria de Puig**: paid tribute to its former Chairperson and President of the Assembly;
