## To the members of the Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media

### Synopsis of the meeting held in Strasbourg on 23, 24 and 25 April 2013

The Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media, meeting in Strasbourg with **Mr Piotr Wach** (Poland, EPP/CD) and **Mr Hans Franken** (Netherlands, EPP/CD) in the chair,

- on Tuesday 23 April from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m., as regards:
  - **Election of a Vice-Chairperson:** elected Mr Hans Franken (Netherlands, EPP/CD) 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice-Chairperson by acclamation;
  - **Membership of sub-committees:** approved the lists of members of its three sub-committees, as presented in the appendix;
  - **Ethics in science and technology** (*Rapporteur: Mr Jan Kaźmierczak, Poland, EPP/CD*): unanimously approved the amendments to be tabled by the committee;
  - **Council of Europe Museum Prize 2013** : held an exchange of views with:
    - Dr David Fleming, Director of the Museum of Liverpool, winner of the 2013 prize,
    - Ms Goranka Horjan, Chairperson of the European Museum Forum (EMF),
    - Prof Dr Klaus Schneider, Director of the Rautenstrauch-Joest Museum, Cologne, winner of the 2012 prize;
  - **Good governance and enhanced quality in education** (*Rapporteur: Mr Paolo Corsini, Italy, SOC*): considered an outline report;
- on Wednesday 24 April from 2 p.m. to 3.30 p.m., as regards:
  - **Culture and education through national parliaments: European policies** (*Rapporteur: Ms Anne Brasseur, Luxembourg, ALDE*): considered the amendments tabled to the draft resolution;
  - **Young Europeans: an urgent educational challenge** (*Rapporteur: Ms Polonca Komar, Slovenia, ALDE*): considered the amendments tabled to the draft resolution and draft recommendation;
  - **Young people's access to fundamental rights** (*Rapporteur: Mr Michael Connarty, United Kingdom, SOC*): considered the amendments tabled to the draft recommendation;

- **Raise the status of technical vocational training** (*Rapporteur: Mr Piotr Wach, Poland, EPP/CD*): decided to change the title of the report to “Raise the status of vocational education and training”; considered an outline report and held an exchange of views with:
  - Mr Antonio Ranieri, Senior Expert, European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training (CEDEFOP), Thessaloniki
  - Ms Monika Schlachter-Voll, Vice-President of the European Committee of Social Rights (ECSR);
- **Replies from the Committee of Ministers**: took note of the reply from the Committee of Ministers (Doc. 13143) to Recommendation 1998 (2012) on *The protection of freedom of expression and information on the Internet and online media*, and asked the Sub-Committee on Media and Information Society to analyse it and to report back;
- **on Thursday 25 April from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m.**, as regards:
  - **Ethics in science and technology** (*Rapporteur: Mr Jan Kaźmierczak, Poland, EPP/CD*): took note there were no other amendments to the draft resolution than the ones tabled by the committee;
  - **Follow-up to Resolution 1920 (2013) on the state of media freedom in Europe**: held a hearing with the participation of:
    - Mr Enzo Iacopino, President of the Italian Order of Journalists, Rome
    - Mr Jean-Paul Costa, former President of the European Court of Human Rights, President of the International Institute of Human Rights, Strasbourg;
  - **References to the committee and appointment of rapporteurs**: took note of the new references to the committee for report and confirmed the rapporteurs appointed in Paris on 12 March 2013, subject to their declarations of absence of conflict of interest:
    - *Increasing transparency of media ownership* (Doc. 13121): Ms Gülsün Bilgehan (Turkey, EPP/CD),
    - *Media responsibility and media ethics in a changing media environment* (Doc. 13122): Mr Mogens Jensen (Denmark, SOC),
    - *Protection of media freedom in Europe* (Doc. 13124): Mr Gvozden Srećko Flego (Croatia, SOC);

appointed Ms Vesna Marjanović (Serbia, SOC) to replace Mr Joseph Falzon (Malta, EDD/CD) as rapporteur on *Europe’s endangered heritage* (Doc. 12999) and heard her declaration of absence of conflict of interest;
- **Committee work programme**:
  - Designation of representatives for forthcoming events*: designated Mr Gvozden Srećko Flego (Croatia, SOC), rapporteur on protection of media freedom, to participate in the meeting of the Sub-Committee on Human Rights of the European Parliament on “media freedom in the Western Balkans and Turkey” and in the European Commission conference “Speak Up!” (19-20 June, Brussels), and asked the members from the concerned countries to consider participating at their own expense;
  - **Next meetings**: decided to meet in:
    - London (21-22 May 2013)
    - Strasbourg, 3<sup>rd</sup> part-session (24-28 June 2013)
    - Strasbourg, 4<sup>th</sup> part-session (30 September - 4 October 2013)
    - Lisbon (25 October 2013)
    - Paris, Council of Europe Office (3-4 December 2013 - tbc).

    - Dr Jean-Philippe Walter, Chairperson, Consultative Committee of Convention No 108;
