Synopsis of the meeting held in Strasbourg on 20, 21, 22 and 23 April 2015

The Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media, meeting in Strasbourg with Ms Adele Gambaro (Italy, ALDE) in the Chair,

- on Monday 20 April 2015 from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m., as regards:
 - **Rethinking the anti-doping strategy** (*Rapporteur: Mr André Schneider, France, EPP/CD*): considered a memorandum;
 - **Increasing co-operation against cyber-terrorism and other large-scale attacks on the Internet** (*Rapporteur: Mr Hans Franken, the Netherlands, EPP/CD*): considered a preliminary draft report and decided to revert to this item at its next meeting;
 - **Media responsibility and media ethics in a changing media environment** (*Rapporteur: Mr Volodymyr Arieiev, Ukraine, EPP/CD*): considered a preliminary draft report and decided to revert to this item at its next meeting;
