Synopsis

of the joint meeting held in Aarhus, Denmark on 3-4 April 2017

The **Sub-Committee on Education, Youth and Sport** and the **Sub-Committee on Culture, Diversity and Heritage** of the **Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media**, meeting in Aarhus with **Mr Thomas Feist** (Germany, EPP/CD), **Lady Eccles** (United Kingdom, EC) and **Mr Mogens Jensen** (Denmark, SOC), **Mr Pierre-Yves Le Borgn'** (France, SOC) and **Alexander, the Earl of Dundee** (United Kingdom, EC) in the Chair,
