Synopsis of the meeting held in Paris on 25 May 2018

The **Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media**, meeting in Paris on 25 May 2018, with Ms María Concepción de Santa Ana (Spain, EPP/CD) in the Chair, as regards:

- **Media education in the new media environment** (*Rapporteur: Ms Nino Gogvadze, Georgia, EC*): considered an introductory memorandum;
- **References to the committee and appointment of rapporteurs:**
 - appointed Ms Judith Pallarés (Andorra, ALDE) rapporteur on *Strengthening the role of young people in the prevention and resolution of conflicts* (Doc. 14494) and heard her declaration of absence of conflict of interest,
 - was informed that following the decision taken by the Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs on 15 May 2018, Mr Jordi Xuclà (Spain, ALDE) was no longer rapporteur on *Threats to academic freedom and autonomy of universities in Europe* (Doc. 14365) and the committee will have to appoint a new rapporteur,
 - took note of the reference on *Defend human rights and the rule of law in the context of international football events* (Doc. 14491) sent to the committee to be taken into account in the framework of the report on *Football governance and ethics: business or values?* (Doc. 14447);
- **Committee work programme:**

held an exchange on the need to ensure good co-ordination between the various ongoing reports in the field of the information society, which dealt with interconnected issues;

Appointment of representatives for forthcoming events: appointed,

with no costs for the Assembly:

 - Mr Mogens Jensen (Denmark, SOC), rapporteur on *Football governance and ethics: business or values?*, to participate in the first "Olympism in Action" forum organised by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) in Buenos Aires, Argentina (5-6 October 2018),

subject to the availability of funds:

 - Mr Raphaël Comte (Switzerland, ALDE), rapporteur on *Jewish cultural heritage preservation*, to participate in the International conference on "Urban Jewish Heritage: presence and absence" in Krakow, Poland (4-5 September 2018);
- **The value of cultural heritage in a democratic society** (*Rapporteur: Alexander [the Earl of] Dundee, United Kingdom, EC*): in the absence of the rapporteur, held an exchange of views with the participation of Mr Andy Pratt, Professor of Cultural Economy at the Centre for Culture and the Creative Industries, City University, London;

- **Safeguarding and enhancing Europe's intangible cultural heritage** (*Rapporteur: Mr Andries Gryffroy, Belgium, NR*): held an exchange of views with the participation of Ms Jorijn Neyrinck, Independent expert on intangible cultural heritage, and Mr Marc Jacobs, Director of the Flemish Interface Centre for Cultural Heritage (FARO), both from Belgium;
- **Public service media in the context of fake news and propaganda** (*Rapporteur: Mr Petri Honkonen, Finland, ALDE*): considered an expert report and held an exchange of views with the participation of Ms Minna Aslama Horowitz, Assistant Professor in International Communication, Finland; Ms Helen Boaden, Member of the Advisory Board, Shorenstein Center on Media, Politics and Public Policy, Harvard University, USA, former Director, BBC Radio, BBC News, London; and Mr Giacomo Mazzone, Head of institutional and members relations, European Broadcasting Union (EBU), Switzerland;
- **Other business**: was informed by Ms Anne Brasseur that this was her last meeting and thanked her warmly for the significant contribution she had made to the work of the committee and the Assembly;
- **Next meetings**: took note of the next meetings of the plenary committee, the Sub-committee on Culture, Diversity and Heritage and the Sub-Committee on Education, Youth and Sport during the 3rd part-session (25-29 June 2018) in Strasbourg.
