## To the members of the Committee on Migration, Refugees and Displaced Persons

### Synopsis of the meeting held in Paris on 13 March 2014

The Committee on Migration, Refugees and Displaced Persons, meeting in Paris, with first Mr Thierry Mariani (France, EPP/CD) and then Mr René Rouquet (France, SOC) in the Chair,

- on Thursday, 13 March 2014 at 9.30 a.m., as regards:
  - **Draft motion for a resolution presented on behalf of the Committee:** approved a motion for a resolution on “The Mediterranean Sea: a front door to irregular migration” with a view to its tabling;
  - **Alternatives to Europe’s sub-standard IDP collective centres** (Rapporteur: Mr René Rouquet, France, SOC): agreed to change the title to “Alternatives to Europe’s sub-standard IDP and refugee collective centres”, approved a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution;
  - **Resettlement of refugees: an efficient tool for greater solidarity in Europe** (Rapporteur: Mr Eric Voruz, Switzerland, SOC): in the absence of the rapporteur, agreed to change the title to “Resettlement of refugees, towards greater solidarity”, approved a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation;
  - **The right to work for refugees** (Rapporteur: Mr Christopher Chope, United Kingdom, EDG): agreed to change the title to “Refugees and the right to work”, approved a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution;
  - **Unaccompanied migrant children: what rights at 18?** (Rapporteur: Ms Mailis Reps, Estonia, ALDE): agreed to change the title to “Migrant children: what rights at 18?”, approved a draft report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution;
  - **Integration of migrants: is Europe failing?** (Rapporteur: Ms Marietta Karamanli, France, SOC): considered a preliminary draft report and authorised the rapporteur to carry out a fact-finding visit to Sweden;
  - **The arrival of large numbers of irregular migrants to Italian coastal areas as a result of tensions in the Southern Mediterranean countries** (Rapporteur: Mr Christopher Chope, United Kingdom, EDG): heard a statement by the rapporteur on the fact-finding visit to Italy on 10-13 February 2014;
  - **Democratic participation for migrant diaspora** (Rapporteur: Mr Andrea Rigoni, Italy, ALDE): in the absence of the rapporteur, decided to postpone this item to a next meeting and authorised him to carry out a fact-finding visit to Turkey;

- **Missing persons in Cyprus:** heard a statement by Mr Jim Sheridan (United Kingdom, SOC) and decided to organise a hearing with representatives of the Committee on Missing Persons in Cyprus (CMP);
- **Evaluation of the implementation of the reform of the Parliamentary Assembly:** considered a response to the letter by Ms Liliana Palihovici (Republic of Moldova, EPP/CD), rapporteur of the Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs, and asked the Chairperson to transmit the Committee reply to Ms Palihovici;
