The Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe, meeting in Paris on Wednesday 15 September 2004 with Mrs Durrieu then Mrs Severinsen in the Chair:

- *Serbia and Montenegro (co-rapporteurs: Mr Miloš Budin, Italy, SOC and Mr Jonas Čekuolis, Lithuania, LDR):* examined, amended and adopted a draft resolution on the functioning of democratic institutions in Serbia and Montenegro;

- *Armenia (co-rapporteurs, Mr Jerzy Jaskiernia, Poland, SOC and Mr René André, France, EPP/CD):* examined, amended and adopted a draft resolution on the implementation of Resolution 1361 (2004) and Resolution 1374 (2004) on the honouring of obligations and commitments by Armenia;

- *Azerbaijan (co-rapporteurs : Mr Gross, Switzerland, SOC, and Mr Andres Herkel, Estonia, EPP/CD):* examined, amended and adopted a draft resolution on the implementation of Resolution 1358 (2004) on the functioning of democratic institutions in Azerbaijan; authorized the co-rapporteurs to visit Azerbaijan on the occasion of the Committee's meeting in Georgia (25-26 October 2004) and again at the time of the local elections scheduled for 10 December 2004;

- *Moldova (rapporteurs: Mrs Durrieu, France, SOC, and Mr André Kvakkestad, Norway, EDG):* held an exchange of views with Mr Braghiș, representative of the Moldovan opposition, on the closing down of schools in the region of Transnistria and the crisis at the TeleRadio Moldova; decided to put this item on the agenda of its next meeting during the the October 2004 part-session;

- *Ukraine (rapporteurs: Mrs Hanne Severinsen, Denmark, LDR, and Mrs Renate Wohlwend, Liechtenstein, EPP/CD):* adopted a declaration on the forthcoming presidential elections;

- *Bosnia and Herzegovina (co-rapporteurs: Mrs Shakhtakhtinskaya, Azerbaijan, EDG and ...):* proceeded to the nomination of Mr Sasi (Finland, EPP/CD) as co-rapporteur;

- *Georgia, Czech Republic and Albania:* decided to postpone these items to its next meeting;

- *Next meetings:*

- in Strasbourg, during the Assembly session (4-8 October 2004)
- in Tbilisi on 25-26 October 2004;
- in Paris on 15 December 2004.
