The Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe, meeting in Strasbourg on Tuesday 5 October 2004 at 8h30 and 14h00 with Mrs Durrieu in the Chair and on Thursday 7 October at 14h00 with Mrs Severinsen in the chair,:

- *Serbia and Montenegro (co-rapporteurs Mr Budin, Italy, SOC and Mr Čekuolis, Lithuania, LDR)*: considered and took position on the amendments tabled to the draft resolution on the functioning of democratic institutions in Serbia and Montenegro;

- *Azerbaijan (co-rapporteurs: Mr Gross, Switzerland, SOC, and Mr Herkel, Estonia, EPP/CD)*: considered and took position on the amendments tabled to the draft resolution on the implementation of resolution 1358 (2004) on the functioning of democratic institutions in Azerbaijan;

- *Armenia (co-rapporteurs: Mr Jaskiernia, Poland, SOC and Mr André France, EPP/CD)*: considered and took position on the amendments tabled to the draft resolution on the implementation of resolutions 1361 (2004) and 1374 (2004) on the honouring of obligations and commitments by Armenia;

- *Georgia (co-rapporteurs: Mr Eörsi, Hungary, LDR and Mr Kirilov, Bulgaria, SOC)*:

- considered a preliminary draft report on the honouring of obligations and commitments by Georgia and decided to transmit it to the Georgian authorities for comments;
- discussed the preparation of the Committee meeting in Tbilisi (25-26 October 2004);

- *Moldova (co-rapporteurs: Mrs Durrieu, France SOC and Mr Kvakkestad, Norway, EDG)* adopted a statement on the situation in the Transnistrian region; authorised the co-rapporteurs to visit the country;

- *Albania (co-rapporteurs Mr Soendergaard, Denmark, UEL and Mr Smoravinski, Poland, EPP/CD)*, authorised the co-rapporteurs to visit the country before the end of 2004 or early in 2005;
