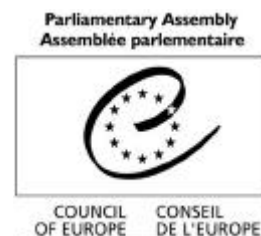

**The Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe**, meeting in Strasbourg on 26 and 28 June 2007 with Mr Lintner (Germany, EPP/CD) in the Chair:

as regards:

- *Moldova* (Co-rapporteurs: Mrs Durrieu, France, SOC and Mr Vareikis, Lithuania, EPP/CD): held an exchange of views on the local elections (3 and 17 June 2007);
- *Montenegro*: appointed Mr Gardetto, Monaco, EPP/CD and Mr Holovaty, Ukraine, ALDE, as co-rapporteurs and decided to follow the developments with respect to the constitutional reform;
- *Ukraine* (Co-rapporteurs: Mrs Severinsen, Denmark, ALDE and Mrs Wohlwend, Liechtenstein, EPP/CD): held an exchange of views on the current political situation in Ukraine;
- *Hearing on frozen conflicts (Berlin, 5-6 November 2007) (to be confirmed and subject to authorisation by the Bureau)*: held an exchange of views on a preliminary draft programme;
- *Monaco* (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Agramunt, Spain, EPP/CD and Mr Slutsky, Russia, SOC): took position on proposed amendments to the draft resolution on the honouring of obligations and commitments by Monaco;
- *Russian Federation* (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Van den Brande, Belgium, EPP/CD and Mr Pangalos, Greece, SOC): held an exchange of views on the organisation of the forthcoming parliamentary and presidential elections, adopted a declaration, and authorised its rapporteurs to carry out a fact-finding visit to the country in autumn 2007;
