**The Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe**, meeting in Paris on 9 September 2009, with Mr Holovaty (Ukraine, ALDE) in the Chair:

as regards:

- *The functioning of democratic institutions in Moldova: implementation of Resolution 1666 (2009)* (co-rapporteurs: Mrs Durrieu, France, SOC, and Mr Vareikis, Lithuania, EPP/CD): held an exchange of views on the draft report with the participation of representatives from the majority coalition and the opposition and unanimously approved a draft resolution;
- *Monaco* (co-rapporteurs: Mr Slutsky, Russia, SOC, and Mr Agramunt, Spain, EPP/CD): held an exchange of views on the draft report and unanimously approved a draft resolution;
- *The war between Georgia and Russia: one year after* (co-rapporteurs: Mr Van den Brande, Belgium, EPP/CD, and Mr Eörsi, Hungary, ALDE): held an exchange of views on the draft report and approved a draft resolution; took note of the statement of the co-rapporteurs inviting all interested members to jointly work out possible compromise amendments to the draft resolution in time for the debate scheduled for the Assembly's 4<sup>th</sup> part-session;
- postponed all other items on its agenda to its next meeting;
- *Other business*: decided to ask the Bureau of the Assembly to instruct the Committee on the Rules of Procedure to study the possibility of incorporating elements of the 2001 Code of Conduct for co-rapporteurs of the Monitoring Committee into the Rules of the Assembly;
- *Next meeting*: decided to hold its next meeting in Strasbourg, during the 4<sup>th</sup> part-session of the Assembly (28 September-2 October 2009).
