Synopsis of the meetings held in Paris on 9 and 10 March 2016

The Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee), meeting in Paris on 9 March 2016, with Mr Cezar Florin Preda (Romania, EPP/CD) in the Chair:

- **Post-monitoring dialogue with Turkey** (co-rapporteurs: Ms Ingebjørg Godskesen, Norway, EC and Ms Nataša Vučković, Serbia, SOC): held a hearing on the recent developments in southeast Turkey and the resumption of the peace process with the participation of:

- Dr Mehmet Tekinarslan, Deputy Undersecretary, Ministry of Interior of Turkey

- Mr Osman Baydemir, Member of Parliament and former Mayor of Diyarbakir, Democratic Peoples' Party (HDP)

- Mr Andrew Gardner, Researcher on Turkey, Amnesty international, and members of the Turkish delegation; adopted a statement on the developments in Turkey; decided to ask the Venice Commission for an opinion on the compatibility of the legal framework governing curfews in Turkey with Council of Europe standards and to request a debate on "Threats to the functioning of democratic institutions in Turkey" during the June 2016 part-session;

- **Ukraine** (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Jordi Xuclà, Spain, ALDE, and Mr Axel Fischer, Germany, EPP/CD): considered an information note by the co-rapporteurs on their fact-finding visit to Kyiv (1-3 February 2016), held an exchange of views and agreed to declassify the information note; decided to ask the Venice Commission for an opinion on the law amending the law on the election of members of parliament (law 3700);

- **Preliminary draft reports on countries not under the monitoring procedure stricto sensu or engaged in a post-monitoring dialogue** (Rapporteur ex officio: Mr Cezar Florin Preda, Romania, EPP/CD): considered the preliminary draft reports on Austria, the Czech Republic and France and held an exchange of views with members of the delegations concerned; decided to transmit these reports to the authorities of the respective countries for their comments;

- **Post-monitoring dialogue with "the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia"** (co-rapporteurs: *Ms Lise Christoffersen, Norway, SOC and Mr Valeriu Ghiletchi, Republic of Moldova, EPP/CD*): heard an oral report by the co-rapporteurs on their fact-finding visit to Skopje, Tetovo and Gostivar (15-18 February 2016);

Republic of Moldova (co-rapporteurs: Ms Valentina Leskaj, Albania, SOC, and Mr Ögmundur Jónasson, Iceland, UEL): heard an oral report by the co-rapporteurs on their fact-finding visit to Chisinau (22-23 February 2016);

- **Authorisation of fact-finding visits**: authorised visits to the Republic of Moldova, "the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia" and Ukraine;

- Next meetings:
 - took note of an invitation by the Finnish delegation to hold a meeting in Helsinki in 2017 in the framework of the celebration of the 100th anniversary of the independence of Finland *(subject to the authorisation of the Assembly Bureau);*

decided to hold its next meetings as follows: Strasbourg, 18-22 April 2016 (during the Assembly part-session) Paris, 23 May 2016 Strasbourg, 20-24 June 2016 (during the Assembly part-session) Tirana, 22-23 September 2016 (to be confirmed and subject to authorisation of the Assembly Bureau) Strasbourg, 10-14 October 2016 (during the Assembly part-session) Paris, 9 November 2016 (to be confirmed) Paris, 14 December 2016 (to be confirmed).
