Synopsis of the meeting held in Strasbourg on 9 April 2014

The Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs, meeting in Strasbourg on 9 April 2014, with Ms Nataša Vučković (Serbia, SOC) in the Chair, as regards:

- **Reconsideration on substantive grounds of previously ratified credentials of the Russian delegation:**
 - . appointed Mr Hans Franken (Netherlands, EPP/CD) rapporteur for opinion and heard from him a declaration on the absence of any conflict of interest;
 - . considered the report presented by the Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee) and unanimously approved the committee's opinion;
- **Evaluation of the implementation of the reform of the Parliamentary Assembly** (*rapporteur: Ms Lilliana Palihovici, Republic of Moldova, EPP/CD*): considered a preliminary draft report and asked the rapporteur to present a draft report at the next meeting;
- **Europe's public administrations in flux: public service under threat?** (*rapporteur: Mr Tiny Kox, Netherlands, UEL*): considered and approved a report and unanimously adopted a draft resolution and a draft recommendation, and asked the rapporteur to present them to the Assembly at its June 2014 part-session;
- **Budgetary matters – Analysis of the use made by the Assembly's political groups of their allocations for 2013** (*general rapporteur: Mr Rudy Salles, France, EPP/CD*): considered and unanimously approved a communication to the Bureau of the Assembly;
- **The post-electoral shifting in members' political affiliation and its repercussion on the composition of a national delegation** (*rapporteur: Mr Jordi Xuclá, Spain, ALDE*): considered an introductory memorandum and asked the rapporteur to present a preliminary draft report at a next meeting;
- **Hearing on the prevention and eradication of corruption within the judiciary** (Helsinki, 27 May 2014, in the framework of the meeting of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, participation of an ad hoc sub-committee): took note of the draft programme;
- **Next meetings:**
 - . in Paris (Council of Europe Office) on 15 May 2014 (morning)
 - . in Strasbourg, during the Assembly's 3rd part-session of 2014 (23-27 June 2014).
