The Committee on Rules of Procedure, Immunities and Institutional Affairs, meeting by videoconference on 30 November 2020, with Ms Ingrid Schou (Norway, EPP/CD) in the Chair, as regards:

– **Gender representation in the Parliamentary Assembly** (*Rapporteur: Ms Nicole Trisse, France, ALDE*): considered a draft report and, following an exchange of views, decided to continue the discussion at a next meeting on the basis of a revised draft report;
