### Synopsis of the meeting held in Strasbourg from 28 to 30 January 2014

  - **Composition of the Committee's Bureau:** elected by acclamation:

  - **Social services in Europe: legislation and practice of the removal of children from their families in Council of Europe member States** (*Rapporteur: Ms Olga Borzova, Russian Federation, EDG*): heard a report by the rapporteur on her fact-finding visit to Romania on 21-22 October 2013 and took note of an analysis of replies to an ECPRD questionnaire on the question in the files;
  - **Measuring the well-being of European citizens** (*Rapporteur: The Earl of Dundee, United Kingdom, EDG*): considered an introductory memorandum and modified the title of the report as follows "Measuring and fostering the well-being of European citizens";

      - Combating sexual violence against children: towards a successful conclusion of the ONE in FIVE campaign;
