Synopsis of the meeting held in Paris on 21 September 2016

The Committee on Social Affairs, Health and Sustainable Development, meeting in Paris on 21 September 2016, with Ms Stella Kyriakides (Cyprus, EPP/CD), Chairperson, and (for the item "Ensuring access to healthcare for all children in Europe") Ms Sílvia Eloïsa Bonet (Andorra, SOC), First Vice-Chairperson, in the chair, as regards:

- Human rights and ethical issues related to surrogacy (Rapporteur: Ms Petra De Sutter, Belgium, SOC): considered a revised draft report in camera, decided to change the title to "Children's rights related to surrogacy", rejected the amended preliminary draft resolution and adopted the amended draft recommendation, with a view to presenting the report for debate in the Assembly during the fourth part-session 2016;
- The need for fiscal and social justice, and public trust in our democratic, financial and tax system (Rapporteur: Mr Stefan Schennach, Austria, SOC): considered a draft report, decided to change the title to "Lessons from the "Panama Papers" to ensure fiscal and social justice", and unanimously adopted a draft resolution, with a view to presenting the report for debate in the Assembly during the fourth partsession 2016;
- Female genital mutilation in Europe (Rapporteur: Ms Liliane Maury Pasquier, Switzerland, SOC): considered and unanimously approved a draft opinion, including five amendments to the draft resolution tabled;
- Developments in the social functioning of trade unions / An urgent call for increased solidarity: the right to work, the right to strike (Rapporteur: Mr Ögmundur Jónasson, Iceland, UEL): considered an introductory memorandum, decided to change the title to "Reinforcing social dialogue as an instrument for stability and decreasing social and economic inequalities", and held an exchange of views with the participation of Dr Aristea Koukiadaki, Senior lecturer in employment law, University of Manchester, United Kingdom, and Ms Renate Hornung-Draus, Managing Director, Director European and International Affairs, Confederation of German Employers (BDA);
- Balancing the right to work, the right to strike: decided not to prepare a separate report on this subject, and agreed to inform the Bureau that no action would be taken on this reference;
- Ensuring access to healthcare for all children in Europe (Rapporteur: Ms Stella Kyriakides, Cyprus, EPP/CD): considered a draft report;
- Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) and its implications for social rights, public health and sustainable development (Rapporteur: Mr Geraint Davies, United Kingdom, SOC): considered an introductory memorandum;

- The employment rights of female workers from Eastern Europe (Rapporteur: Mr Viorel Badea, Romania, EPP/CD): heard a statement by the Rapporteur following his fact-finding visit to the International Labour Organization (ILO) in Geneva, Switzerland, and held an exchange of views with Ms Silvia Dumitrache, President of the A.D.R.I. Romanian Women's Association (Italy);
- Sub-Committee on the Europe Prize: heard a report by the Chairperson of the Sub-Committee on its meeting held in Girona, Spain, on 8 July 2016, and approved the revised proposals on the modernisation of the Europe Prize with a view to them being included in the progress report of the Bureau at the fourth part-session 2016 for ratification by the Assembly;
